The American chestnut was an essential component of the entire eastern U.S. ecosystem. This late-flowering, reliable, and productive tree is unaffected by seasonal frosts and was the single most important food in America for a wide variety of wildlife from bears to birds.

Mature American chestnuts have been virtually extinct for decades due to disease. The disappearance of these trees has resulted in a profound change in the composition of forests in the eastern United States.

Redwoods are the tallest and largest trees on the planet. They support unique biodiversity including greenery, fungi, other trees, endangered wildlife, and birds. The shade these trees provide helps filter the water in rivers and streams benefitting fish.
